BOOK KEEPING AND ACCOUNTING (Level - 1)

Basic Knowledge

အခြေခံသိမှတ်စရာများ နှင့် ဝေါဟာရများ

Book-keeping

is the systematic recording in their books of account of the business transaction of a business. This recording and keeping work of the account book is called as Book-keeping.

Accounting

is the process of identifying, measuring, summarizing, recording and communicating economic tranactions. It is also interpreting their effect on the affairs of a business.

Assets

is all the properties of a business and two type of assets are tangible assets and intangible assets.

Tangible assets include land and buildings, plant and machinery, fixtures and fittings office furniture, stock, investment, debtors and cash.

Intangible assets include goodwill, pantents, copyrights and trademarks.

Capital

is the total of money and property supplied to a business by its owner. (owner contribution).

Liabilities

is an amount of money in a business that is owed to someone and has to be paid in the future.

Accounting Equation

(2) [Assets = Capital + Liabilities (loan)]

Credit

is a person will pay what he owes. An entry on the right-hand side of an account.

Creditor

A person or organization to whom money or something is owned for services or goods.

(ကုန်ပစ္စည်းအကြွေးတင်ခြင်း (သို့)ဝန်ဆောင်မှုလုပ်ငန်းများအတွက် ပိုက်ဆံ(သို့) တစ်စုံတစ်ခု အကြွေးပြန်ပေးရန်ရှိသောလူပုဂ္ဂိုလ်၊အဖွဲ့အစည်းများကိုလုပ်ငန်း၏မြီရှင် (creditor) ဟုခေါ်သည်။

Example.(2) Mr John buy goods on Credit \$ 200.

eg. (6) Owner takes cash from business for his own use \$ 300.

Debit

is an accounting entry acknowledging sums that are owing. An entry on the left-hand side of account.

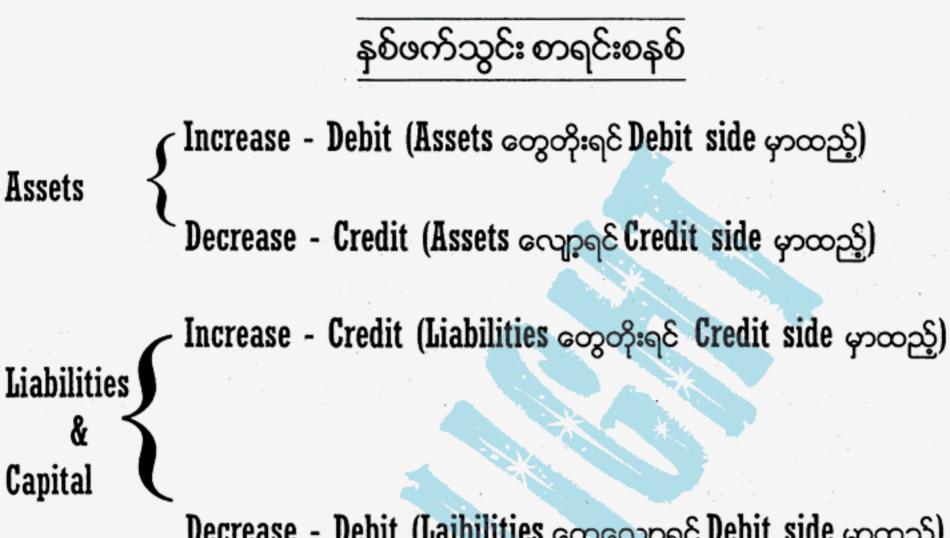
Debtors

is a person or organization that owes money to another person or organization.

Double entry book-keeping

Every transaction must be enter twice, once on the debit side in one account and once on the credit side in another account.

c/d = carrige down (closing balance)

b/d = brough down (opening balance)

Personal Account Accounts used to record transaction with persons.

(လူပုဂ္ဂိုလ်အနေဖြင့် စာရင်းသွင်းလေ့ရှိသောအကောင့်ကိုခေါ်သည်။)

e.g- Debtors, Creditors [Debit side is Receiver. Credit side is Supplier.]

Note - Debtors - မိမိဆီမှကုန်များကိုအကြွေးဝယ်သောသူ (Debit nature) Creditor - မိမိဆီသို့ကုန်များကိုအကြွေးရောင်းသောသူ (Credit nature) The Receiver လက်ခံရရှိသူ The Supplier ပေးသွင်းသူ

Real Account is relating to tangible things.

(လက်ဆုပ်လက်ကိုင်ပြနိုင်သောပစ္စည်းများကိုစာရင်းသွင်းသောအကောင့်ကိုခေါ်သည်။) e.g- Land, Building, Cash, Bank, etc...[Credit-What come out][Debit-What come in].

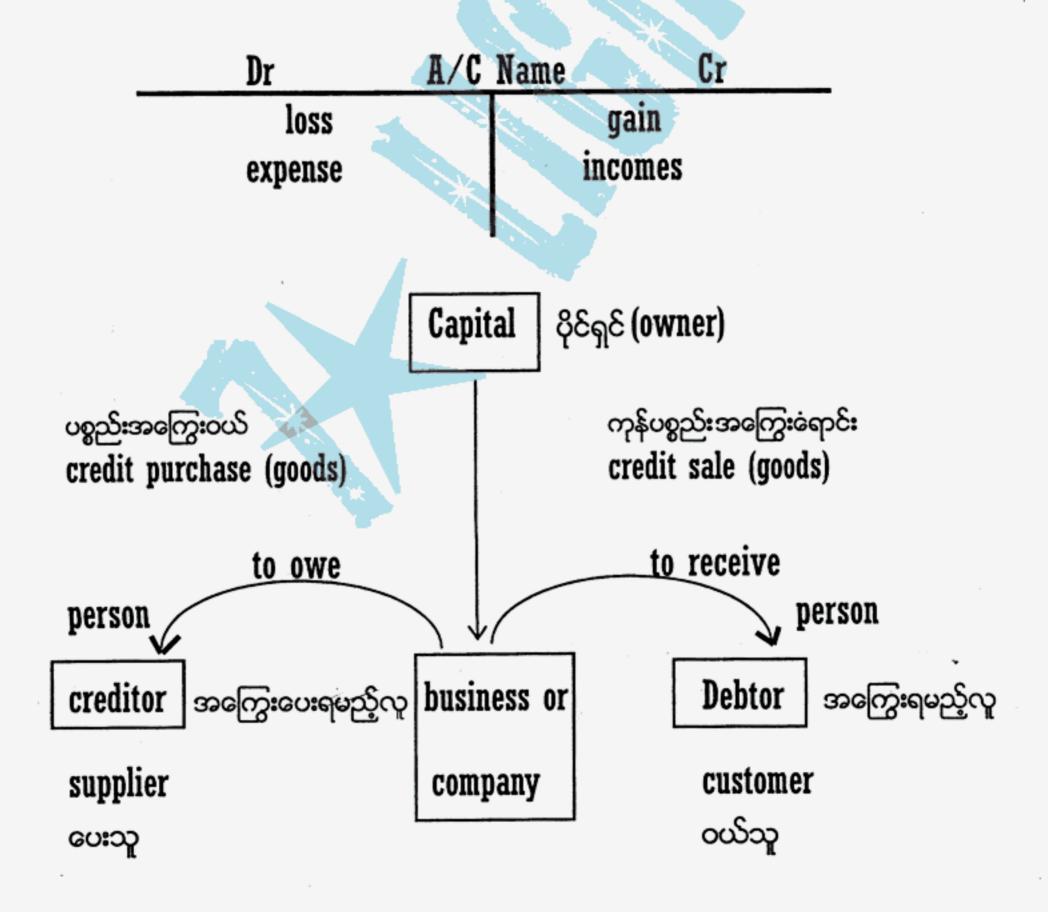
